MEALS

For the 2021-2022 school year, the U.S. Department of Agriculture has extended its waiver program to ensure all Herron Classical Scholars receive high-quality, nutritious meals. For this reason, all HCS Scholars are eligible for one free breakfast and one free lunch per day. Free meals apply to standard breakfast and lunch only – a la carte items will incur a charge regardless of lunch status.

A flat fee has been assessed for **TEXTBOOK FEES** for the core classes that all students take. This fee includes math, science, social studies, English and Latin classes. The fee has been assessed by grade level.

The Supply Fee includes a lab fees for Science, Music and Art classes. It also covers the costs of the student planner and ID. The State of Indiana covers a portion, but not all of consumable supply fees for students eligible for Free & Reduced Lunch.

A \$25 discount is offered on the Supply Fee for families that pay ALL fees in full by December 31, 2021. The entire balance must be paid in full to receive the discount.
